



Unifesp Call for Postdoc or Young Talent with experience abroad

Unifesp Institutional Internationalization Project (PrInt-Unifesp)

Capes-Print Program

The Rectorate for Graduate Studies and Research of the Universidade Federal de São Paulo (Unifesp) makes public the call for the selection of candidates for Postdoc or Young Talent fellowships with experience abroad, related and not related to the projects approved at Unifesp's Institutional Internationalization Project (PrInt-Unifesp) in the framework of Capes Call N.41/2017.

I -Objectives of the Capes-Print Program

- 1. To promote the construction, implementation and consolidation of the strategic plans for internationalization of the institutions contemplated in priority areas of knowledge;
- 2. To stimulate the formation of networks of international researchers aiming at improving the quality of the academic production linked to graduate studies;
- 3. To expand actions to support the internationalization of graduate studies in the contemplated institutions;
- 4. To promote the mobility of faculty and students, with emphasis on doctoral students, postdoctoral researchers and faculty from abroad linked to *strict sensu* graduate programs with international cooperation;
- 5. To encourage the transformation of participating institutions into an international environment;
- 6. To integrate other Capes development actions into the internationalization effort.

II -Categories

The execution of the activities at Unifesp aims to contribute to the advancement of strategic themes and Unifesp institutional development.





Postdoc with experience abroad

To attract researchers or faculty, Brazilian or foreign, residing in Brazil or abroad, who have relevant academic and scientific experience abroad (as full PhD abroad, postdoc or sandwich doctorate for at least 12 months abroad), for teaching or research activities in projects and Graduate Programs participating in the PrInt-Unifesp.

Young Talent with experience abroad

To attract talented young researchers, Brazilian or foreign, residing abroad, who have relevant academic and scientific experience abroad (full PhD degree abroad, sandwich PhD or postdoc for at least 24 months abroad) for teaching or research activities in projects or Graduate Programs participating in the PrInt-Unifesp.

III- Duration

Postdoc: The duration of the fellowship will be minimum of 6 months and maximum of 12 or 24 months according to the project.

Young Talent: The duration of the fellowship will be minimum of 6 months and maximum of 12 months.

IV- Eligibility requirements

Postdoc with experience abroad

- 1. To be a foreign or Brazilian researcher who has developed a research project abroad for at least 12 months or has obtained a PhD degree in a foreign institution, in one of the areas of research of PrInt-Unifesp;
- 2. To have a scientific production compatible with the position in one of the research areas of PrInt-Unifesp;
- 3. To have a ORCID or Research Gate registration number.(Registration is free and can be subscribed at https://orcid.org/ or https://www.researchgate.net).





Young Talent with experience abroad

- 1. To be a foreign or Brazilian researcher who has developed a research project abroad for at least 24 months or has obtained a PhD degree in a foreign institution.
- 2. To be a permanent resident in a foreign country.
- 3. To have a scientific production compatible with the position in one of the research areas of PrInt-Unifesp;
- 4. To have the ORCID or Research Gate registration number. (Registration is free and can be done at https://orcid.org/ or https://www.researchgate.net).

V- Fellowship and Benefits

Monthly allowances, flight tickets, installation assistance and health insurance according to Capes Call N.41/2017.

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VI- Documentation

Applicants must provide all documents listed below, and all of them must be submitted in English.

- a) Complete the electronic application form.
- b) **Research project.** Emphasize the relevance of the proposal in terms of the appropriation of a new domain area and/or technology platform for the development of one of the areas of research of PrInt-Unifesp. Include a plan of activities with schedule. The document must have a maximum of ten (10) pages of spacing 1.5, Times New Roman 12, with margins of 3.5 cm to the left and 1.5 cm to the right;
- c) **Curriculum Vitae**. An updated CV for non-Brazilian applicants or a Lattes CV for Brazilian applicants;
- d) Link of Lattes Curriculum of the host researcher. It is mandatory that the faculty host to be accredited to a Graduate Program participating at PrInt-Unifesp;
- e) **Acceptance Letter** of the host researcher, including title of the project, duration of the project (start and end dates), in letterhead and signed (digitally).

VII - Obligations

It is the responsibility of the selected researcher:

- 1- To check with the competent consulate the required documentation visa application and approval and sanitary requirements;
- 2- To commit and sign the provisions of the Commitment Terms of the Capes Call N.41/2017 AnnexVII.





- 3- Foreign applicants to fellowships in Brazil who are not native speakers of Portuguese or English must present one of the three language proficiency proof:
 - declaration of the host institution stating that the candidate has language proficiency in Portuguese or English, sufficient for the proposed activities;
 - certificate of proficiency of Brazilian Portuguese language (Celpe-Bras);
 - certificate of English proficiency: (a) TOEFL IBT Internet-Based Testing: minimum of 71, validity within 2 years; b) TOEFL ITP Institutional Testing Program: minimum of 527, validity within 2 years; c) IELTS International English Language Test: minimum of 6 in average, but at least minimum of 5 in each category (listening, reading, writing e speaking), validity within 2 years; OR d) Cambridge certificates: CPE/C2 Proficiency, CAE/C1 Advanced or FCE/B2 First, validity not required.

VII. Deadline

The final deadline for applications is October 28, 2020.

IX. Selection process, appeal and notification of results

The evaluation of the applications will be done in two steps, in a comparative way, based on the documentation presented in item VI.

The first step will be carried out by the coordinators of the research projects participating in the theme based on the analysis of the documents requested in item VI. The pre-selected applications will be forwarded by the theme coordinator to the Management Group that will realize the final evaluation and validate the results.

The final result will be published by Unifesp Graduate Studies and Research Office on the website according to the schedule presented at the item below.

Unapproved candidates may appeal by sending a message to capesprint@unifesp.br within 2 days after the release of the final result. The Management Group will respond to the appeal and homologate the result.
